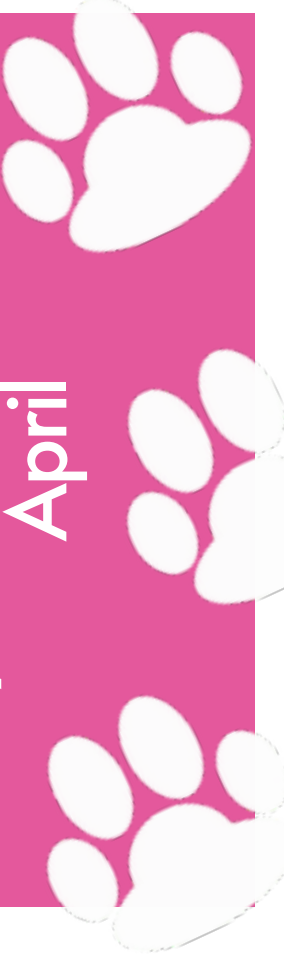

Discover what these devices have in common, how they differ, and learn basic operating tips.

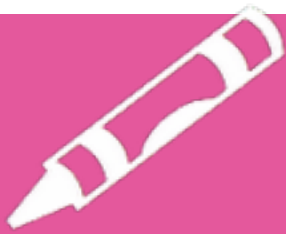

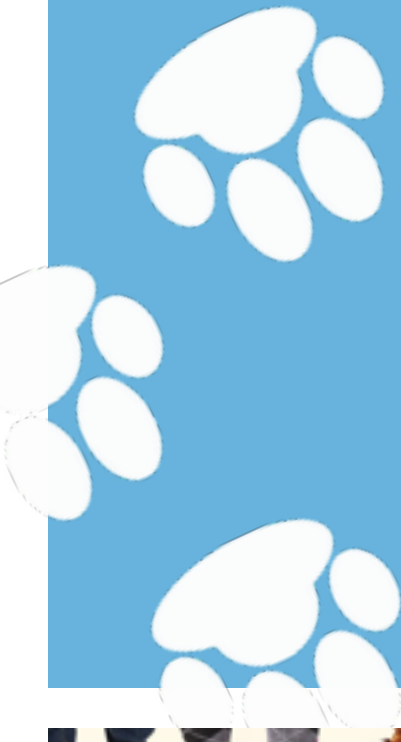

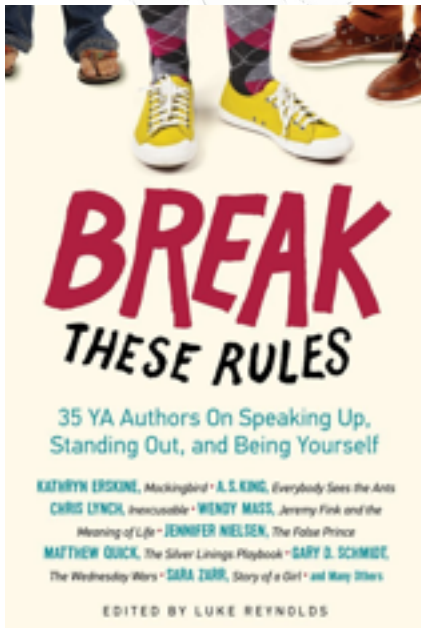
