Our library is excited to share in Stacy's celebration of all of her hard work. Copies of her book are also available for check out. Reserve your copy today, call 509-865-2800 x6.



### Find your applications By Heidi Iniguez

The Win+X menu is useful, but no substitute for the old Start menu as it doesn't provide access to your applications. Press Ctrl+Tab, click the arrow button at the bottom left of the Start Screen, or swipe up from the bottom of the screen and a list of your installed programs will appear. If you can't see what you need immediately, start typing an application name to search for it. Or, in Windows 8.1, click the arrow to the right of "Apps" to sort your programs by date installed, most used, category or name.

## Sasquatch Books

Our Library has recently made available several books on Sasquatch or Bigfoot. Check out these new titles to the library collection.

Bigfoot, also known as Sasquatch, is the name given to a *cryptid* (an animal whose existence or survival is disputed or unsubstantiated, such as the yeti.) ape- or hominid-like creature that some people believe inhabits forests, mainly in the Pacific Northwest region of North America. Bigfoot is usually described as a large, hairy, bipedal humanoid. The term Sasquatch is an anglicized derivative of the Halkomelem word *sásq'ets*.

Most scientists discount the existence of Bigfoot and consider it to be a combination of folklore, misidentification, and hoax, rather than a living animal, because of the lack of physical evidence and the large numbers of creatures that would be necessary to maintain a breeding population.






