

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RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE YAKAMA NATION TREATY DAY PARADE Friday, June 10th, 2022

1. <u>Deadline for parade applications will be Friday, June 3rd, 2022.</u> Honorary parade participants will not be judged.

- 2. On-site parade registration table will be at the Cultural Center (North end) and set-up will open at 7:30 am the day of parade. Please enter from the south entrance for check in at the registration table <u>prior to line-up</u> to receive your number for the parade.
- 3. Registration will close promptly at 9:15 a.m. to ensure the parade begins on time. Please place your parade number in the front of your parade entry in plain view.
- 4. Float space is limited to 30 ft spaces; no oversized vehicles or semi-flatbeds allowed. With limited space available please abide to rules of float size.
- 5. Please state if there will be more than one vehicle or entry on your parade application.
- 6. Only Vehicles/Floats entering the parade will have entrance to parade line up parking. NO PERSONAL/PROGRAM VEHICLES ALLOWED TO PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF THE PARADE LINE UP. You will be allowed to drop off decorations only, <u>no parking</u>.
- 7. Limited Parking will be allowed at the Cultural Heritage Center north-end grass area (near Hwy 97) for parade participants and at Legends Casino's east-end parking lot for dismantling of parade floats.
- 8. Float participants may wear a mask (optional) and maintain social distancing following COVID-19 safety Guidelines. Must supply own sanitizer for float area.
- 9. There will be no intermingling between floats to maintain social distancing. Employees assisting with fabrication, set-up, decorating, and/or cleanup who are not riding on the float must clear the area before 9:15.
- 10. Judging will take place by the community using the Cultural Center's Facebook Page during the parade with <u>most "Likes</u>." Photos will be posted of all floats on the Cultural Center Facebook Page (The parade will be streamed live on Facebook). Winners will be posted on the Cultural Center Facebook page.
- 11. If you plan on giving out candy or passing out information, it must be ready for handout. There must be runners ready for handouts. PLEASE DO NOT STOP OR HOLD TRAFFIC UP. **Please take precautionary measures for the safety of children**.
- 12. Floats with horses must provide their own cleanup crew (pooper scoopers)
- 13. We appreciate all YN Elected Officials, YN Employees, YN Enterprises participation and encourage your program/enterprise to decorate your float according to the parade theme.
